Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we welcome Fr. Michael Dolman, our Vocations Director. In addition to giving us great encouragement, he will also be making an appeal for the Clergy Training Fund which pays for the training of the priests and deacons of our diocese. I hope you will be very generous.

Julie Gallagher's funeral is going to be on Tuesday 10th November at 10.45 am. She is being buried at Oscott Cemetery. At present only 30 people are allowed to attend a funeral. I shall let you know more about the arrangements next weekend.

Next Sunday, 1st November, is the Solemnity of All Saints and the following day is All Souls Day. On All Souls Day we shall have public Masses at 9.30 am at St. Joseph's and at 7 pm at Sacred Heart. At Sacred Heart the All Souls book with the names of the faithful departed is on the table in the porch and you can add any more names that you wish. At St. Joseph's there are All Souls envelopes for you to take in which to put the names of those you wish remembered and you can then put the envelope in the box in front of the altar on All Souls Day.

We shall start have two public weekday Masses. Wednesday at 10 am at Sacred Heart and 12 Noon on Fridays at St. Joseph's. It would be good to have a number of people at these, so do come if you can.

This Sunday's Gospel is Jesus' summary of the Law bringing together Deuteronomy 6:5 and Leviticus 19:18. To love God and to love your neighbour as yourself. On these two commandments hang the whole of the Law, and the Prophets also. Love is not about feelings, but about the whole direction of our will. To love God we need to bring our wills into line with God's will. "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven". And to will the good of others, our neighbours, which means the people with whom we come into contact in our daily dealings. Our minds and our wills can become very clogged up so it is important the keep on resetting them. We are given the sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist to make this easy for us.
