Thought for the Week ahead...

From 1st September to 4th October (which is the Memorial of St Francis of Assisi) the Christian Churches mark what has become known as the Season of Creation, a special time which is associated with the fruits of the harvest, during which we give thanks for God's Creation and reflect on our part in protecting it now and for future generations. In his celebrated teaching document on Care for Creation – Our Common Home, Laudato Si (Praised be to you), written in 2015, Pope Francis reminds us that when God gave humanity the command: "Be Fruitful, multiply; be masters of the whole of Creation" he gave us the earth to care for it and not to dominate it. In simple ways, by our awareness of the beauty of Creation, by our lifestyle choices about the environment, and by thanksgiving, we can re-dedicate ourselves to this each day.
